- Service Design an iterative approach that concerns itself with understanding the user world; perspective, needs, motivations, emotions and experiences
- 2. Service design engages in sense making to help visualize, understand and then improve complex systems and services
- 3. Service design uses the concept of 'Value in Use' as way to think beyond the purely physical

What are services? What is service design?



Services are complex, hybrid artifacts. They are made up of things – places and systems of communication, and interaction – but also of human beings and their organisations. They therefore belong to the physics of nature and technical systems and to biology, but also to sociology and the culture of human beings. Permeated with human activity as they are, with a network of relationships between people, and people and things at their centre, they can never be reduced to the simplicity of mechanical entities.' (Manzini 2011. P.1.)
